### MINUTES

#### Attendance and Apologies

#### Minutes and Matters Arising from: Last Committee Meeting 30.7.2014

Matters Arising: It was not possible to formerly approve the minutes of the meeting due to the absence of recorded minutes. Those at the present meeting who had been in attendance at the last meeting were not aware of any matters arising that were not already included on the current meeting agenda.

#### 3. Officer Reports

##### 4. Treasurer:

JI reported that the cost for holding 1940's Dance on the 19 income received covered the cost with a small surplus of £8.89. The current balance of funds is £4,384.18. Should the project for repairing Paradise Lane go ahead (current cost £4,500), CMBC and the Warley Trust have between them promised to cover just over two thirds of the cost leaving a balance of approx. £1000 to come from WCA. No final decision taken as yet to go ahead with the project.

##### 7. Events:

All at the meeting agreed that the "1940's Dance" had been a great success. Thanks were expressed to JI and all who in any way helped with the event before, on the day and clearing up afterwards.

##### Future Events

- Céilidh – 11 October 2014 at St John's Church Hall. Plans were at an advanced stage. Posters and tickets should be available from the beginning of September. Live music will be provided by The Rob Thorn Band.

- Rushbearing Festival - 6/7 September - the usual arrangements for the Rushbearing Festival coming to Warley Village on the Saturday morning will be taking place. JI is coordinating activities including food arrangements. Anyone able to help please contact JI direct.
  - Outdoor Remembrance Service – 9 November 2014. Village Centre. Arrangements are in hand. The event will follow the same pattern as last year with the service taking place mid-morning followed by a procession to St John's Church afterwards, followed by refreshments.
  - Victorian Christmas Fair and Carols around the Christmas Tree – 6 December 2014.
8. **History Group: DMc** - DMc reminded the meeting that there was a meeting of the HG immediately following the end of the current evening's WCA committee meeting. The main topic of the HG meeting was to be history about local farms and associated matters. There also was to be reference to the 2015 WCA Calendar and opportunity to see a proof copy. Anyone wishing to help sell the new calendar or purchase copies need to contact JI. Price of calendars will remain at £5, same as last year. There will be four hundred to sell and copies will be available from the Rushbearing Festival weekend.
9. **In-Bloom:** JS informed the meeting that there were areas of the village, in particular on pavements that were in need of weeding. JI brought up the need for some work to be carried out in connection with the removal of any hard woodcuttings from the compost bins, which will be taken away by the safer greener team. Bins then to be emptied and the compost to then be spread on existing planted areas. The bins, then can be either repaired or renewed.
- At JW's request, SR informed the meeting of the success of a recent NGS event involving SR and Warley House Garden's and that £1,964 had been raised to go to the Overgate Hospice. SR expressed her thanks to everyone who had in anyway given their help towards the event by contributing cakes or any other way.
10. **Community Engagement:** The meetings attention was drawn to the disgusting state of the public telephone box in the village. SR agreed to contact BT to raise the matter, establish the standards applied by BT in relation to public telephone boxes and see what could be done to improve the situation.

### 11. Current Projects

- There has been no recent progress made in relation to the Graveyard Database long term project. It was reported that Peter Fleming, (Hope URC, Highroad Well) would be relinquishing his role as secretary of the Warley cemetery in due course as he will be leaving the area. Who will take on being the future contact regarding the cemetery, is not known, but hopefully in due course Hope URC will be able to provide the information.
- It was agreed to remove the Heritage Audit project heading from future agenda's as it is no longer was applicable.
