It was noted that the Warley Craft Circle had been reformed to become the Warley Circle. There was discussion around and its new aim to provide a range of activities, trips and events, rather than its previous focus which was purely on craft-related activity. There was much enthusiasm within Warley Circle amongst its members. It was noted that there was potential for some overlap between Warley Circle and the Association in terms of activities and events.</li> <li>b. Paradise Lane - WCA still awaiting a response from the Council (via Cllr. Evans)</li> <li>c. 20 mph – AB’s report on issues raised by residents regarding traffic and infrastructure, including 20mh, posted on WCA website. Vandals Rugby Club – JV</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will be a May Ball at the Clubhouse as part of the 90th year celebrations. Details to be forwarded to WCA asap.</li> <li>• JV reported that dog fouling on the pitches as well as on the surrounding ground had got to impossible levels, with nasty consequences for players. The Club are to put up their own ‘strong’ notices and unless it improves may soon take action to stop people from entering their private land completely.
