**Minutes of Committee Meeting 7 00pm 9<sup>th</sup> January 2015 held at the Maypole Inn Warley. In Attendance: Eliana Bailey (Chair); Andrew Berry; Chris Crowther; Tony Fall; Kathryn Gallagher; Sylvia Ketley; June Illingworth (Treasurer); David McCallam, Shari Taylor and John White (Secretary). Apologies: Tony King (CMBC), Janet Blackburn and PC Hayley Ratcliffe (Neighbourhood Police).**

- 1 Welcome - Eliana welcomed all in attendance to the meeting and invited Tony Fall (prospective LA Conservative candidate) to introduce himself to those in attendance.**
- 2 Minutes - As there were no minutes recorded from the last committee meeting which took place prior to the AGM on the 25<sup>th</sup> November 2014, there were no matters arising to discuss.**
- 3 Paradise Lane - Andrew Berry provided an update of the work undertaken from the bottom of the lane by the allotments as it joins Paradise Lane to the bottom of Paradise Lane towards where the school playground ends. The tarmac work is completed except for a couple of places by the allotment side wall. A bollard will need repainting and the idea of possibly placing some planters was mentioned. There is some tidying up work to do and the better tarmac finish has created a need for some**

**further patch up work to be carried out bottom side of the allotments in front of the recreation ground area. Andrew was thanked for all the time he had given to seeing through the Paradise Lane project.**

**4 Open Gardens - Andrew Berry informed the meeting that there are to be three specific open days under The National Garden Scheme taking place in the village during the year at which the profit from money raised through admission charges, will be given to charities.**

**5 Warley House gardens will be open 10/5/15 and 13/5/15 from 1 00pm to 5 00pm, admission £4 00.**

**Edgeholme and Greenhill House (two house gardens) will be open 12/7/15 from 11 00am to 5 00pm, admission £5 00. There is also the possibility that some allotments may also be open to the public on the July date.**

**It was mentioned at the meeting that Andrew Berry's name needed to be removed from the WCA website in relation to being the contact name for tree planting.**

**6 History Group - The meeting were informed that the December meeting held at The Winterburn, had been well received by those in attendance. With the aid of a projector and screen loaned by the Hebden Bridge Historical Society, a series of photographs of "Old Warley" had been shown with informative commentary by David McCallam.**

**Details of the first three months of 2015 History meetings were given which are being coordinated by Andrew Berry.**

**7 Treasurer Update - June Illingworth provided a written report to the meeting. She confirmed the Council had paid their contribution to the work undertaken at Paradise Lane. Three hundred and thirty nine (339) 2015 calendars had been sold which produced a profit of £445 00. There had also been £668 48 profit raised from a very successful Christmas Victorian Fayre.**
